COMMITTEE (BRISECC)**

**MEETING RECORD BY THE SECRETARIAT**

**11 JANUARY 17, 2019 BEIJING, CHINA**

Dato. Lee Yee Cheong, the vice president of BRISECC visited the secretariat of BRISECC based in CYSC on Jan. 11, 2018 and met with Ms. Lin Liqin, individual member of BRISECC and the Secretary General of China Association of Children's Science Instructors, Ms. Zhu He, the Deputy Secretary General of BRISECC and staff of the secretariat. The meeting discussed about 2019 plans of panel on science education resources and communicated about work progress since the establishment of BRISECC.

**1. DISCUSSING ABOUT 2019 PLANS OF PANEL ON SCIENCE EDUCATION  
RESOURCES**

The meeting agreed that the panel on science education should further worked on <One Belt One Road: Fusion of Civilization Education Curriculum> in 2019.

**1.1 The first edition of curriculum will be published in China.**

**1.2 Carrying out pilot programs of <One Belt One Road: Fusion of Civilization Education Curriculum>.** Each member organization (ECO Science Foundation, Academy of Sciences Malaysia, China Association of Children's Science Instructors, etc.) involved in developing the curriculum would select 10 local schools for the piloting the curriculum. Before the pilot, there might be online/offline training about how to use the curriculum. For the pilot in China, schools would be chosen from Nanjing (a city in Jiangsu Province of China) and the city where the 3<sup>rd</sup> Belt and Road Teenager Maker Camp & Teacher Workshop would be held in.

**1.3 Dato Lee Yee Cheong would draft the 2019 plan of panel on science education resources as the chairman of the panel.**

**2. COMMUNICATING ABOUT WORK PROGRESS SINCE THE  
ESTABLISHMENT OF BRISECC**

2.1 I-FEST<sup>2</sup>, the International Festival of Engineering Science and Technology in Tunisia held by the Tunisian Association for the future of Science and Technology (**ATAST, a member organization of BRISECC**), would be held from 21<sup>st</sup> to 26<sup>th</sup> of March. The secretariat of BRISECC had confirmed to organize a

Chinese delegation and ATAST had also circulated invitation letter among members of BRISECC.

2.2 National Academy of Sciences (ANAS) and Ministry of Education of Azerbaijan had requested ECOSF to organise an awareness-cum-advocacy workshop on IBSE-LAMAP in next June (2019). Dato Lee Yee Cheong suggested Prof. Manzoor Hussain Soomro, the president of ECOSF and vice president of BRISECC to include the workshop as a program under the framework of BRISECC.
